STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

About

London's prestigious **Architecture Association** have been conducting their annual Summer School programme **Streetware Southeast Asia** in partnership with **Think City**, a community based urban regeneration organisation.

Over the past 4 years the programme has been held in Penang and KL looking at the streetscapes of the city, providing design solutions for specific issues, to make our cities more attractive, user friendly and liveable.

Think City is providing a unique opportunity for 3 students to attend the AA Programme **Streetware Southeast Asia V** in Cebu, Philippines from **13-22 July, 2016**. The scholarship covers AA Membership fees, course fees, flights, accommodation and a per diem. This is open to all current architecture students in Malaysia who have successfully completed at least two full years of architecture studies.

How to apply

Students must select an urban street near where they study/live and **identify one feature of the street that can be improved** such as an item of street furniture (eg post-box, bench, bus stop etc) or an aspect of the street design (eg crossing, pavement design).

Participants are to re-design that feature to improve it, and write a short statement that explains why you selected that feature, what aspects needed improving, and in how the new design helps make the street more user-friendly, contributing to a liveable city.

Submissions will be evaluated by a panel of architects and urbanists from the AA and Think City. Winners will be chosen based upon:

- (i) ability to identify an existing streetscape weakness
- (ii) ability of the design to address the conditions of the site
- (iii) creativity and originality of the design
- (iv) impact of the design on improving the streetscape of the chosen street, and
- (v) ability to replicate the design elsewhere

Submissions

All submissions must be made on the official entry form. All files sent must be in pdf or jpg format, with a maximum of 4 x A3 design panels (excluding the entry form).

Submissions will be reviewed on the basis of the creativity of the design proposition from the formal expression to the narrative of the design concept.

All submissions must include:

- (i) photographs of the street feature that highlight the existing qualities that are to be improved.
- (ii) drawings of their design in 2D and/or 3D.
- (iii) a drawing (plan and/or section) that relates the design to the existing context
- (iv) at least one render or photo collage of the design

Terms and Conditions

All entries must be received no later than **5:00pm Friday 10 June 2016**. Entrants must be aged over 20 years of age and hold a valid passport, and must be prepared to travel to the Philippines between 12-22 July 2016.

Think City reserves the right to display or otherwise publish the submission designs on their website or other medium. The judges decision is final, and no correspondence after the final submission date will be entertained.
